The American Chemical Society is holding a Summer School on Green Chemistry in Washington, DC, June 22-26, 2006. The Summer School directly precedes the 10th Annual Green Chemistry & Engineering Conference: Designing for a Sustainable Future (www.greenchem2006.org), June 26-30.

Program Description.* The program will feature a number of activities designed to provide a solid foundation in green chemistry to all participants:

- presentations by leading researchers and educators in green chemistry and engineering,
- collaborative problem-solving projects,
- student presentations, and
- discussions on the role of green chemistry and engineering in solving global challenges.

Please note that English is the official language of the Summer School.

Eligibility. The Summer School is open to graduate and post-doctoral students studying in the Americas. Applicants should be interested in developing collegial relationships through the Summer School that will result in future collaborations on research projects, conferences, and workshops.

Application Procedure. The applicant should send a curriculum vita or résumé including the following information:

- Name, Department, Institution, Faculty Advisor
- Mailing Address, Telephone, Fax, and Email of Applicant
- Degrees and Education Experience Including Unofficial Transcript of Graduate Courses
- Industrial Experience (if any)

These materials must be accompanied by:

- 1) Letter of nomination from the applicant's faculty advisor, and
- 2) Brief (one-page) essay by the applicant concerning his/her interest in green chemistry, including any previous experience with the field and how he/she will benefit from participation in the Summer School.

Electronic applications are preferred and should be sent to gsummer@acs.org.

Deadline for receipt of applications is April 15, 2006. Notification of acceptance will be made on or before April 30, 2006. Further information can be found at:
